Project Management for the Modern Workforce

This track is designed for business professionals who want well-rounded skills in managing a multitude of projects in any industry and those who seek a pathway to a project management role or career. This track goes beyond traditional project management knowledge, providing students the opportunity to expand their expertise and successfully respond to organizational change in areas of technology, logistics and personnel management, effective communication, data analysis and efficiently built structures. Upon successful completion of this program, students will be prepared to pursue the Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM) or the Project Management Certification (PMP).

TRACK SPECIFIC COURSES

- **LEAD 220 Data Analytics in Organizations – 3 Hours**
This course focuses to develop the knowledge, skill, and ability to manage, analyze, and present data needed to understand human dynamics in the organizational environment
- **LEAD 314 Diversity in the Workplace – 3 Hours**
Examine various aspects of diversity and inclusion from a societal perspective, and within the workplace environment. Various human resource management principles will be discussed, and this course will also review, analyze, and ascertain themes of diversity including, but not limited to race, ethnicity, culture, socio-economic status, worldview, the LGBTQ community, persons with disabilities, socio-cultural factors, legal perspectives, and more
- **LEAD 412 Coaching and Talent Development – 3 Hours**
This course addresses knowledge, skills, and dispositions for workforce leaders in talent management, career development, and coaching strategies to maximize performance and goal attainment at individual, group, and organizational levels
- **LEAD 490 Leadership and Management - 3 Hours**
Introduction and application to the management functions of planning, organizing, leading, and controlling as they apply to leadership of workplace learning and performance
